Dear Neighbour

In the next couple of weeks we will be starting landscaping works associated with the construction of the new thick juice tank. Our plan is to have all the earthworks and tree planting completed and established before we consider starting construction of the tank.

The first phase of works will be the clearing of trees and vegetation from the area which we want to complete well before the spring so there is no impact on nesting, birds, bats or other wildlife. Alongside this we will be erecting bird and bat nesting boxes in adjacent areas of the site. The picture below shows the area where the vegetation will be cleared.




Once campaign operations have been complete we will then move into phase II which will be moving soil onto the area and the construction of the new bunding and landscaping.

Phase III will follow in Autumn 2014 which will be the planting of the new trees and shrubs.
